NONTRAFFIC INCIDENT DATA COLLECTION


(a).... the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration shall establish a method to collect and maintain data on the number and types of injuries and deaths involving motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of not more than 10,000 pounds in non-traffic incidents.

K.T. Safety Act of 2007

Public Law 110-189 Signed 2/28/2008

- SEC. 2. (f) Database on Injuries and Deaths in Nontraffic, Noncrash Events.
- (1) . . . shall establish and maintain a database of injuries and deaths in nontraffic, noncrash events involving motor vehicles.
- (2) . . . The database established pursuant to paragraph (1) shall include information regarding:
- the number, types, and causes of injuries and deaths resulting from the events described in paragraph (1);
- the make, model, and model year of motor vehicles involved in such events, when practicable; and
- other variables that the Secretary determines will enhance the value of the database.

Non-traffic Crashes

- Motor vehicle traffic accident
 - ANSI D16.1-2007 "Manual on Classification of Motor Vehicle Traffic Accidents"
- Non-traffic accidents location
 - occur OFF roads customarily open to the public - driveway 'backovers', parking lots, etc.





Noncrash Incident Examples

- Hypo/Hyperthermia
- Window injuries
- Trunk entrapment
- Carbon monoxide poisoning (unintentional)
- Battery acid
- Radiator cap

- Jack failure / improper jack use
- Hands caught in closing car doors
- Falls off a parked vehicle
- Falls while exiting a parked vehicle





NiTS Data

- Not previously collected by NHTSA
- Crashes off the trafficway (road environment)
- Non-crash incidents involving motor vehicles
- Fatality & injury data
- Count & detailed data





A Virtual System

- Uses multiple existing systems
- NHTSA databases and other sources
- More complete picture than one system





Noncrash Injuries

- National Electronic Injury Surveillance System-All Injury Program (NEISS-AIP)
- Data: Emergency department records





Noncrash Fatalities

- Source: National Vital Statistics System (NVSS)
- Data: Death certificates





In-depth SCI Investigations

In depth research into individual crashes





NiTS provides...

- Information not routinely collected
- Estimates of problem size
- Detailed information for nontraffic crashes
- Useful aggregates for noncrash incidents
