FRAM PRODUCT UPDATE

Another opportunity we are working is an application for our 256K parallel FRAM in an automotive 'black box' system. The fast write capability of FRAM can be used to store up-to-the-second information on a car's operating data at the time of airbag deployment. FRAM is an enabler for this application since the desired functionality cannot be gained with any other nonvolatile memory technology. We expect to receive our first order for this application this year with growth planned for 2002.
