## INTRODUCTION

The Seventeenth Annual International Workshop on Human Subjects for Biomechanical Research met in Washington, D.C. on October 4, 1989. Due to the scheduling of a Volvo/AAAM afternoon meeting on the subject of head trauma, the Workshop could only hold a morning session. Within this time constraint, we scheduled eight presentations and allowed enough time for discussion. About 80 people attended the Workshop.

I wish to thank the Stapp Conference Advisory Committee for its support of this activity, and Mone Asensio and Jeff House of the SAE for coordinating the meeting room assignment and providing audiovisual support. Shirley Lawsen of Wayne State University performed the arduous task of interpreting the taped discussions following each presentation. Arthur E. Hirsch, Barbara Hennessey, Lotta L. Chi, and others from Chi Associates helped prepare the Workshop and publish the Proceedings.

Consider papers appearing in the Proceedings as workshop or non-formal publications, i. e., do not reference the Proceedings in the open literature.

This was the seventeenth meeting of the Workshop. Over 17 years, there have been changes in the individual participants, the research organizations represented, and the sophistication of visual aids. The basic purpose of the Workshop -- as understood by the original committee seventeen years ago -- may also be changing. Originally, the Workshop would provide a forum for the exchange of ideas or the presentation of current studies in surroundings that emphasize participation in problem-solving efforts. I perceive that the discussion following the presentations is decreasing and the Workshop is taking on a formal atmosphere. Next year, let's encourage more participation and spontaneity in the Workshop discussions.

Our coming Workshop meeting, the Eighteenth, will be held in Orlando, Florida in November 1990.
